To prepare the Pre-Commercial Procurement (PCP) call for tenders, CRANE is conducting an Open Market Consultation (OMC) process with potential tenders from the 18<sup>th</sup> of April to the 20<sup>th</sup> of June of 2022. This will help CRANE to further refine and improve its views about the available technologies, capabilities and possibilities. The OMC thus will serve two purposes:

1. Gathering information from potential market suppliers about the state of the art
2. Informing the market about the procurement plans and needs of the public healthcare system

### CRANE CONSORTIUM PREPARATORY WORK



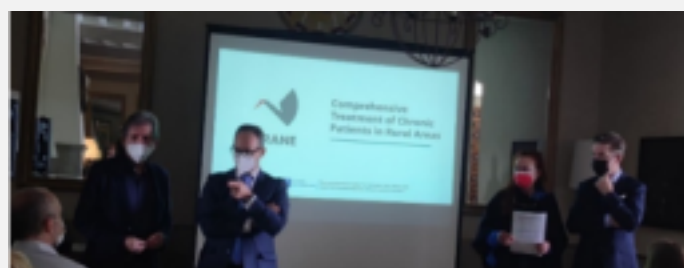

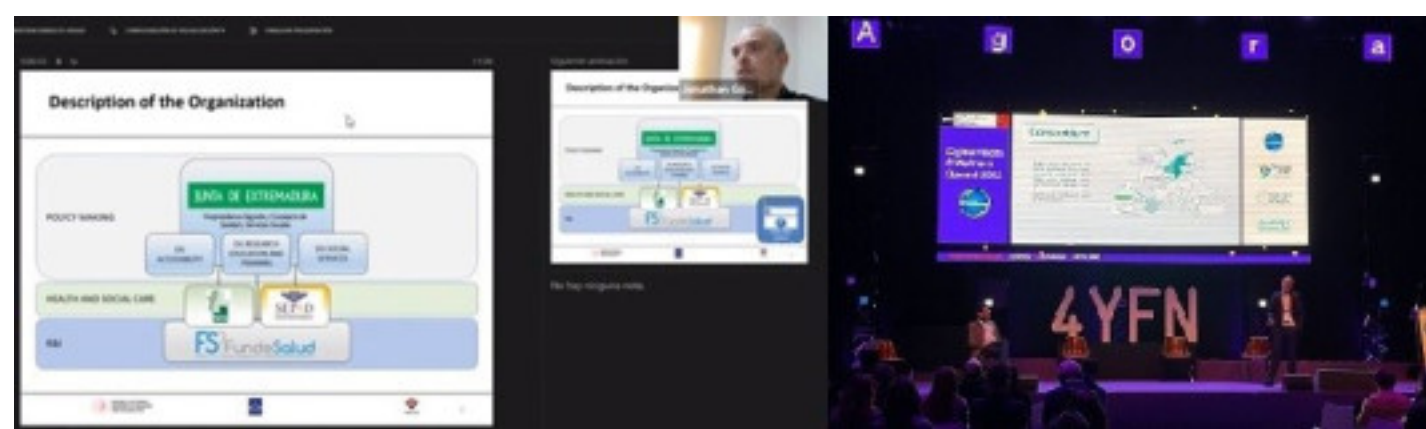
#### WHO visiting CRANE

The Centre for Rural Medicine was visited by WHO on the 22-25th of February 2022. WHO was introduced to the Centre for Rural Medicine and took also great interest in the presentation about the PCP project CRANE and its vision. According to WHO, CRANE has a highly innovative approach which may not fit all member states of WHO, still WHO are looking forward to seeing how this initiative will be materialised in future.



#### Presentation in Extremadura

CRANE OMC preparation meeting was followed on 10 March by an event to promote the project. There, the different partners presented the starting point of the project, the strategic horizon of the model proposed by CRANE and how to maximise its impact in rural areas of Spain, Sweden and Norway. The project aims to move towards a model of care that facilitates the self-care of chronic patients in rural areas of Europe.



#### International Networking: Cancer Missions and Mobile World Congress (4YFN) presentation

CRANE, which focuses on the comprehensive treatment of chronic diseases in rural areas, aims to create a health care system that enables chronic patients to engage in self-management. Jonathan Gómez Raja, Chief Scientific Officer at FundeSalud, presented the project on two different days: on 14 February 2022 during the International Networking Event on Cancer Missions and on 2 March 2022 at the Mobile World Congress (4YFN) in Barcelona. The aim is to attract companies that can participate in the development of this Public Procurement of Innovation project.



#### Introduction of CRANE to the I4H cluster in Agder

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of April, Ingrid Kjarstad, innovation advisor leading CRANE in Agder (Norway), presented the project and its vision in a meeting held by the healthcare innovation cluster I4H. 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#### TIQUE OMC Results event

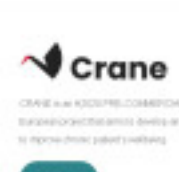
On Thursday 7 April, TIQUE presented the conclusions gathered during the Open Market Consultation that was held from October 2021 to February 2022.
